

# Thornburg Limited Term Income Fund

DECEMBER 31, 2018

## Investment Strategy

The Fund is an actively managed, laddered portfolio of short/intermediate investment grade obligations with an average maturity of less than five years. Laddering involves building a portfolio of bonds with staggered maturities so that a portion of the portfolio matures each year; cash from maturing bonds is invested in bonds with longer maturities at the far end of the ladder. The strategy is a good compromise for managing different types of risk.

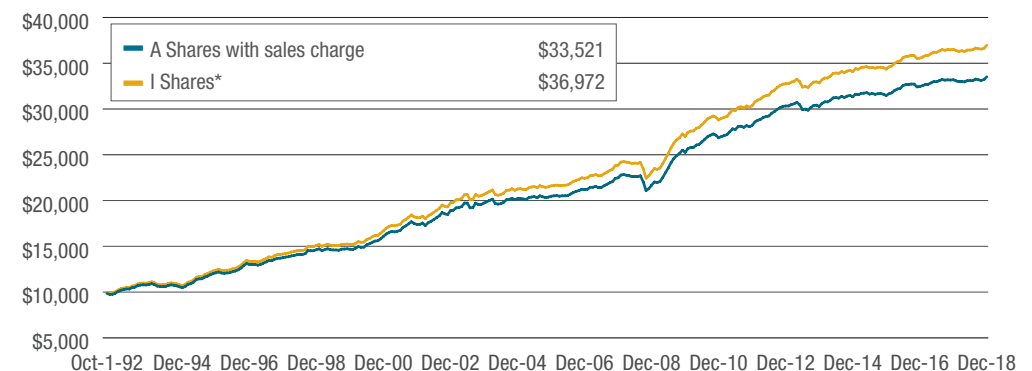

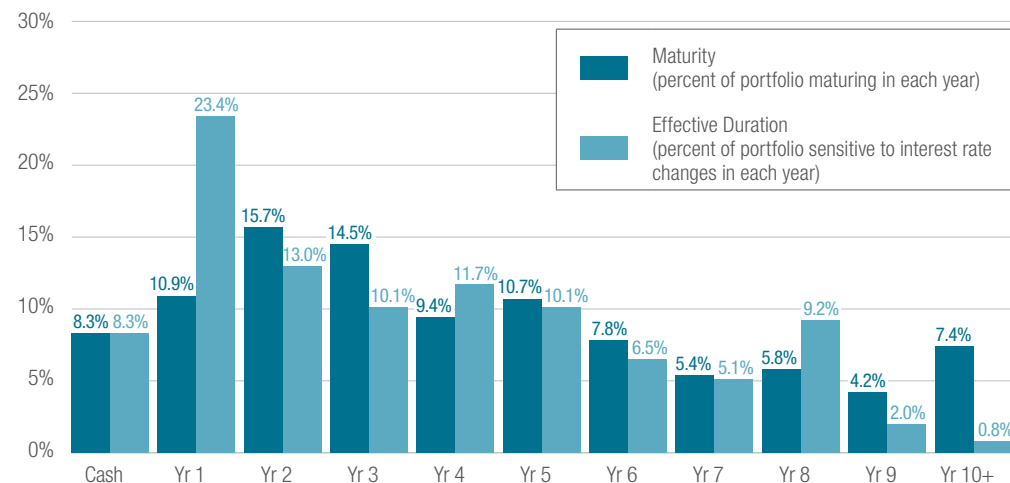
