What is a Trusted Contact Person?

A trusted contact person, who must be at least 18 years old, is someone you designate that Thornburg may contact in case of emergency or incapacity. Designating a trusted contact is not required, and does not authorize the named individual to transact or make changes to the owner's account.

You can add, remove, or change a trusted contact person at any time by notifying Thornburg in writing.

While this is an optional account feature, assigning a trusted contact person may be an important safeguard that could help us to protect you and your assets. No action is required if you do not wish to add a trusted contact person.

Trusted contact must be 18 years of age or older.
